Dereham Road travel improvements – Project update

Delays to outstanding utility works outside of our control have held up our completion of the overall project but we are pleased to report these works have now been completed and our contractors will shortly return to site to finish the final phase of works, as outlined below:

Breckland Road / Dereham Road Cul-de-Sac

Completion of all outstanding highway works around the bus gate area on Breckland Road and the Dereham Road cul-de sac will commence on Monday 16th September and will run for a total of six weeks, subject to weather conditions.

During this period, a daytime road closure will be necessary for two days along the Three Mile Lane / Dereham Road to Breckland Road section. This will likely take place in late October and the precise date will be communicated nearer the time.

Dereham Road – Longwater Lane / Dereham Road Junction

Temporary lights will be erected, and a lane closure will be implemented to complete outstanding traffic signal works at the Longwater Lane / Dereham Road junction.

Works will commence on Monday 30 September 2024 and run for a total of one night from 7:30pm to 6:00am, subject to weather conditions.
