

Norfolk County Council proposes to make a Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (the "Order") (STRO11770) affecting the C162 Longwater Lane from its junction with A1074 Dereham Road for 50m north eastwards ("Road A") and A1074 Dereham Road from its junction with C162 Longwater Lane for 50m eastwards ("Road B") in the Town of Costessey to facilitate Anglian Water laying a new supply for a fire hydrant, the Road A will be temporarily closed/restricted (except for pedestrian access), traffic over the Road B shall be prohibited from using the eastbound leftmost lane and shall be subject to the imposition of a 30 mph speed restriction for the duration of the works/period the closure is necessary which is anticipated to be from 18<sup>th</sup> November to 6<sup>th</sup> December 2024, but may continue to be closed/restricted until the 17<sup>th</sup> January 2025 where the closure/restriction is still required beyond the anticipated dates.

Alternative route is via: Longwater Lane, West End, Townhouse Road, Norwich Road, Dereham Road.

**NB** – Please note that the closure of C162 Longwater Lane is only expected from the 2<sup>nd</sup> to 6<sup>th</sup> December 2024.

Vehicular access will be permitted to a final destination in the Roads A and B where signs indicating such access is possible and permitted are in place.

The Order shall automatically revoke on the completion of the works/when the restrictions are no longer necessary or otherwise on the 17<sup>th</sup> January 2025 without further notice.

If necessary, the restriction could run for a maximum period of 18 months from the date the Order is effective.

A person who contravenes, or who uses or permits the use of a vehicle in contravention of the restriction/closure imposed by the Order shall be guilty of an offence.

Penalty: £1000 maximum fine on conviction and/or endorsement for contravention.

In the event of the start date being delayed the new start date will be displayed on site in advance.
